Patient Search Tips

First try searching by patient's first name, last name and date of birth (enter the date of birth as a string of numbers, i.e. enter January 1st, 2008 as 01012008).

If you can not find the patient, try searching by:

- Patient's first initial and date of birth
- Patient's last name and date of birth
- Patient's first and last names only
- Chart Number
- Patient first and last initial with the wildcard characters % or _ .
 - Note: You must enter a wildcard character in the first and last name.

Wildcard Character Examples

- The percentage (%) wildcard character is useful when you are unsure how a name is spelled and can be used to replace multiple letters. (e.g. unsure if the name is Janet or Janice).

(%) Wildcard Example: We could enter Jan% for the first name and click on the SEARCH button to locate all names that begin with JAN.

- The underscore wildcard character (_), is useful when you are unsure of how a name is spelled but know it is a single letter (e.g., we are unsure if the name is Diane or Diana)

(_) Wildcard Example: We could enter Dian_ for the first name and click on the SEARCH button to locate all names that begin with DIAN.

Use the **birth name** of the patients instead of “Baby Boy”, “Baby Girl” or Twin as the first name. Baby and Twin names are difficult to match with actual records if the last names are common.



If the patient is part of a multiple birth (twins or triplets or more), add the birth order and the birth count.  Optional -- This vaccine may be administered today. Although the usual "recommended" date has not been met, the minimum valid date for this dose has been met.

Printing Patient Records

Patient immunizations can be printed out as requested by the patient or other medical personnel. Be sure to follow confidential document policies for your facility when giving records to patients.

To access an Immunization Record for a patient, you must search and select that patient.

1. Once you are on the Patient Demographic page, click on the **State Reports** link below the **Reports** heading.
2. Click on the **Patient Record** link.
